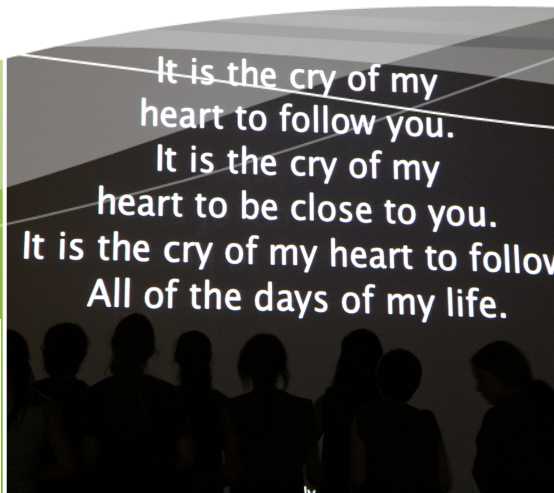


Support Checkpoint Bible Camp

Checkpoint Bible Camp is designed for 3rd through 9th graders and is divided into two camps: a junior camp (3rd – 6th grade) and a middle school camp (7th – 9th grade).
